


Competitive Analysis: Finding the Gap

- 3 of the apps connect the user to a PT
- All 4 provide progress tracking with clinically validated assessments + exercise videos
- 1 app (Joint Academy) offers social accountability with patient community groups
- Lack of motivation management: 1 offers daily encouragement but still depend on user to have that motivation to begin with (unguided internet-based self-help)
- Little to no specific attention placed on addressing negative psychological responses
